



In parts of Africa, wars have been going on for many years. Everyday life in countries such as Sudan, Ethiopia, and Somalia is difficult. Millions of people have lost their homes, markets, and hospitals. In these conditions, food supplies disappear and people face hunger. During the past ten years, international aid organizations have done their best to help prevent hunger by (a) sending food to people in the war areas.

However, this is (b) a short-term solution. Most aid workers agree that giving food to a country in war is only a temporary measure.
