



People are living in community, interact with each other, and the term responsibility is regarded as a crucial component to consider. Passage A describes the case of neighbours not willing to help the person who got stabbed. This case can be understood with the notion of 'avoid making choices' introduced in passage B, which explains that people tend to refuse making choices for their safety. To overcome the situations described in A, 'individual social responsibility' discussed in passage C is necessary.

The situation described in passage A has a relation with the notion mentioned in passage B. According to passage A, a bar manager gets stabbed by a stranger and calls for a help at the middle of the night. Although several neighbours heard the noise, the call for the police was almost thirty minutes after the crime. It was later found out that neighbours thought someone else would take care of the situation. This can be explained in passage B's perspective, the notion of 'avoid making choices'. Just as an example of a sheep that often move altogether to avoid wolf's attack, people also have a tendency to deny choosing and rely on others to take care of it, mostly because they fear the risk afterwards. Passage C introduces 'individual social responsibility', which is the notion of people to engage in community for their development, by actively participate in various social issues. In order to overcome such cases shown in passage A, it is necessary for people to consider passage C's statement.

The notion of 'individual social responsibility' can be a solution for the case described in passage A. The major reason why neighbours didn't call the police as soon as they heard the noise was the sense of being individual. They thought it wasn't their duty to take care of other's situation, and with the fear of taking the risk by making a choice being added, they expected others to do the job for them. However, in order for the society to develop, the social bond between individuals is necessary. All the members of the society should engage in the development of their community by actively taking part of their position. However, simply doing their job won't contribute greatly for the success of their community. They also need to have a interest, and sensitivity towards



various social issues, and consider those as their job to deal with. If the policy isn't fair enough, people should call for the change by going against it. Marthin Luther King Jr. for example, he stood up for the freedom of black people. If he had a fear, or wished someone else to speak up, black people may not overcame the inequality today. Therefore, it is important for people to engage in society. If something is wrong, be courageous to make a change. In the end, the society would change to the way everyone wish to live.
