

## 2015년 국가수준 학업성취도 평가

### 고등학교 2학년 영어

지금부터 듣기 평가를 시작하겠습니다. 선다형 1번~15번과 서답형 1번~3번 문제는 듣고 푸는 문제입니다. 녹음 내용을 잘 듣고 물음에 답하기 바랍니다. 내용은 한 번만 들려줍니다.

#### 【1번】 대화를 듣고, 남자의 심정으로 가장 적절한 것을 고르시오.

M: Mom! Where are you?

W: Here in the kitchen, sweetheart.

M: Guess what, Mom. I finally got a part in the musical!

W: That's wonderful! I was worried you might not pass the audition for the school musical again.

M: Well, you encouraged me not to give up. So I decided to give it another try.

W: I'm so proud of you. What role are you going to play?

M: All of the audition judges loved my voice. They offered me the main character!

W: Wow, you're playing the leading role. Congratulations!

M: Thanks, Mom. I can't wait to be on stage.

**【2번】 대화를 듣고, 두 사람이 대화하고 있는 장소로 가장 적절한 곳을 고르시오.**

W: Hey, Brian! I'm sorry I'm late.

M: That's okay. What happened?

W: This is my first time here, and I took the wrong bus.

M: Oh, I should've told you which one to take to get here.

W: That's all right. Because of you, I get to appreciate these painting masterpieces. Thanks for inviting me.

M: My pleasure. I was sure you'd like this exhibition. (*Pause*) Look! That's the famous "Sunflowers" by Vincent van Gogh!

W: Oh, I never dreamed I would see the original painting in person.

M: Me, neither. Look at the colors and the brush strokes he used. Aren't they amazing?

W: Yes, they are!

**【3번】 대화를 듣고, 두 사람의 관계로 가장 적절한 것을 고르시오.**

M: Congratulations, Ms. Decker!

W: Thanks, Mike.

M: Can you tell the television viewers how you felt when you got the highest mark?

W: I was surprised! I did badly during rehearsals.

M: I see. After losing the 2010 World Skate Championship, you just disappeared. What happened?

W: I injured my leg and lost my confidence.

M: Then, how did you overcome all of that and win again?

W: I started seeing a counselor, and I practiced every day with my coach.

M: Your hard work paid off. Thanks for the interview. This is Mike Anderson from CBA Sports News.

**【4번】 다음을 듣고, 남자가 하는 말의 주제로 가장 적절한 것을 고르시오.**

M : Hello, students! Out of our five senses, hearing is the one most commonly lost from preventable causes. To avoid any kind of ear problems, you should take care of your ears. Here are some things you can do. First, keep your music at a low volume. Next, take special care when in the water. That is, try not to get water in your ears when bathing, showering, or swimming. Finally, although many people clean inside their ears at home, doctors highly advise against this. If you have trouble hearing, see your doctor right away.

**【5번】 대화를 듣고, 여자가 남자에게 부탁한 것으로 가장 적절한 것을 고르시오.**

(*Cell phone rings.*)

M : Hello, Mary. What's up?

W : Hi, Uncle Jack. Do you have time today?

M : Well, I have a job interview at the local TV station this afternoon. Why?

W : I bought a new audio system, but I'm having a problem with it.

M : Oh, you finally bought one. So what's the problem?

W : I'm having difficulties connecting all these cables. Can you help me?

M : Don't worry. You know I worked at an electronic appliance shop before.

W : That's why I'm asking you. Can you come and set up the audio system?

M : Sure, I'll be there tonight.

**【6번】 다음을 듣고, 여자가 메시지를 남긴 목적으로 가장 적절한 것을 고르시오.**

(Beeping sound)

W: Hi, Steve. This is Stacy. I called you several times before, but you didn't answer. Maybe your cell phone battery was dead. Anyway, Lucy and I are still at the airport waiting for our plane to take off. The announcement says that the plane has some minor engine problems and it'll take about three hours to fix them. So, the departure time has been delayed to five o'clock. Could you pick us up at Wellington Airport at seven o'clock instead of four? I'll call you again if there are any further changes to our flight schedule. See you soon.

**【7번】 대화를 듣고, 남자가 꽃값으로 지불할 금액을 고르시오.**

M: Hello, I'm looking for flowers for Mother's Day.

W: Come in. (Pause) What about this tulip bouquet? It's only 15 dollars.

M: It's pretty. But I prefer carnations.

W: Then, how about this special bouquet?

M: Very nice! I think my mother will love it, but it looks very expensive.

W: Normally, this bouquet is 40 dollars. But we have a special half-price event for Mother's Day.

M: Twenty dollars? Hmm, that's not bad.

W: Well, if you order and pay today and pick it up tomorrow, you can get an extra 2 dollars off.

M: Good! I'll pay now and come back tomorrow.

**[8번] 대화를 듣고, 남자가 학생 발명 대회 출품작을 변경하려는 이유를 고르시오.**

W: Hey, James. Are you ready for the student invention contest?

M: Not really.

W: Why not? Was it too difficult to make a sample?

M: No. Actually, I have to find a new item for the contest.

W: Why? I liked your idea of an umbrella with a cup holder.

M: Yeah, so did I. I thought I could win the contest with it.

W: It sounded very useful and practical. So what's wrong?

M: Well, I saw a similar kind of umbrella on the Internet. Someone already invented it.

W: Oh, I'm sorry to hear that. So have you come up with a new idea?

M: Not yet, but I'll find one soon.

**[9번] 대화를 듣고, 두 사람이 주문하기로 결정한 것을 고르시오.**

M: Carol, have you ordered our club T-shirts yet?

W: Not yet. I'm looking at the designs. How about these striped ones?

M: We had striped T-shirts last year.

W: Then, let's choose the plain one with short sleeves.

M: Well, won't it be too cold to wear short sleeve T-shirts?

W: Right. They're for our field trip in October. Long sleeves would be better.

M: Okay. One more thing. We need to choose one between the round-neck and V-neck designs.

W: The V-shaped necklines look better.

M: I agree. So let's order this design.

**【10번】 대화를 듣고, 여자가 최종적으로 선택한 시계를 고르시오.**

W: Jake, can you help me choose a watch from this brochure?

M: Sure. Who is it for?

W: It's for me. I lost my watch last week, so I need a new one.

M: That's too bad. Let's see... I guess digital watches are more stylish than analog ones.

W: Yeah, I agree. (*Pause*) What kind of band matches the digital one better?

M: I think both silicon and leather match well. But silicon is easier to take care of.

W: Okay. I'll buy one with a silicon band.

M: Good. Then you should choose one of these two models.

W: Well, since I cannot spend more than \$50, I'll get this one.

M: Good choice!

**[12번] 대화를 듣고, 빈칸에 들어갈 말로 가장 적절한 것을 고르시오.**

W: Hey, Dongsu. Did you hear that Juri is coming back home?

M: Yeah. Why don't we throw her a party?

W: Great idea! She's been studying abroad for two years, right?

M: Yes. I bet she's really homesick. So I'm thinking we should have some Korean food for her.

W: Good! I can prepare Sikhae.

W: Wow! That'll really surprise her. She'll really feel like she's back home.

**[13번] 다음을 듣고, Susan이 Paul에게 할 말로 가장 적절한 것을 고르시오.**

W: Susan is walking to school in the morning. On her way, she meets one of her classmates, Paul. He's riding his bicycle to school. After saying hello to each other, Paul asks Susan if she's ready for her presentation today. At that moment, Susan realizes that she left her USB drive at home. Her presentation file is in it. She has to go back home. But she might be late for school if she walks. She thinks if she uses Paul's bicycle, she could get to school on time. In this situation, what would Susan most likely say to Paul?

**【14번】 대화를 듣고, 여자의 마지막 말에 대한 남자의 응답으로 가장 적절한 것을 고르시오.**

M : Honey, what's bothering you? You look worried.

W : Well, I can't stop thinking about the living room heater.

M : The heater? Why?

W : I'm not sure whether I turned it off or not. Maybe not. Did you check?

M : No. But don't worry about it. I'm pretty sure you turned it off.

W : I hope so, but what if I didn't? We won't be back home until this Friday.

M : Well, do you want me to turn around and drive back home?

W : Yes. I won't be able to enjoy this trip with the heater thing on my mind.

M : The City Theater. It starts at 7 o'clock and ends around 8:30.

M : Can you do that? But don't you usually leave your office at 6 o'clock?

W : Well, I need to work late today. Maybe until 8:30.

M : That's great. I'll be in the bookstore near the theater after the show.

M: Exactly! Plus, you can attach pictures, video, or audio.

W: Terrific! I should try that service, too.

**【서답형 2번】 다음을 듣고, 빈칸에 적절한 말을 주어진 철자로 시작하여 한 단어로 쓰시오.**

M: Hello, listeners! This is Dr. Daniel Benson from the Public Health Department. Would you like to have a turkey and cheese sandwich for lunch? What about dark chocolate for a snack? They might be tasty. But do you know these foods can sometimes cause headaches? Some foods contain chemicals that can bring on an extremely painful headache. Once you suspect something may be the cause of your headaches, write it down and avoid eating it for a few months to see if you get fewer headaches.
