

Heifer International helped more than 30,000 families in forty-six countries.

If you want to receive a Heifer animal, you must first explain your needs and goals. You must also make a plan which will allow you to become self-supporting. Then the organization provides you with animals and necessary training.

A person who takes part in the program also becomes a giver. That is, anyone who receives a Heifer animal must agree to give that animal's first female baby to other people in need. This concept of "passing on the gift" helps this movement spread around the world.
